

PAC Meeting Minutes

May 13, 2015

- Introductions, Ms. Sendejo and Mr. Landry were present.
- Mrs. Williams: Pre-K teacher and principal intern broke down results of parent survey for us via powerpoint
- Survey was open for 2 weeks and there were 85 responses
- There were less responses this time using electronic only surveys. However, some parents suggested that maybe it was the same amount of responses because it was specifically stated to fill out one survey per family. Last year some parents filled out a survey for each child.
- There was a lot of discussion on volunteers and to make sure that parents know that there are different levels/opportunities to volunteer. For example, you may not be an approved volunteer but you can still make copies, etc.
- It was suggested that at the beginning of the year that a FAQ go home for the big questions.
- There was a lot of discussion of homework and academics. There were questions on to why some grades seem to have so much more homework. Mrs. Sendejo said that student might be hitting the grade where the TEKS changed. Mr. Landry said it would be beneficial for parents to know of changes. This would be especially beneficial for parents with multiple children. Fourth grade the second time around may look different than it was for a first child. It was suggested a parent orientation from each teacher explaining expectations for each grade, homework expectations and any TEKS changes.
