- I. Jennifer Carpenter opened the meeting and introduced the following Lena Pope/CHA administration members in attendance:

- II. Volunteer to take minutes

- III. Mrs. Carpenter reviewed the goals/mission of the Parent Advisory Council.
- IV. Mr. Ramirez presented the 3-D “fly through” of the planned expansion. Administration answered questions regarding the expansion. Reiterated that all students must be dropped off and picked up through the carpool lane during construction (2017-18 school year). Hulen parking lot will be closed for construction. Families using Clayton will receive instructions on where to park, as they must walk their students in. This may also impact parents having lunch with students. One parent inquired about safety patrol; this is yet to be determined. Another parent suggested utilizing parents to help with dismissal process.
- V. Mr. Ramirez gave update on SMART camp; applications are still being accepted. We have approximately 15 spots left. There are several fun field trips planned, including indoor sky diving and Fox Sports News. Camp only costs \$25 per student.

Will continue to revise parental involvement policy at first meeting of year. Most parents feel Wednesdays at 8 am is fine for meeting days/times for next year.
